DIFFICULTY =

YARN = [Aran Tweed](#) by Laines du Nord:

Main Color (cod06) :10 balls

Contrasting Colors: 1 ball each color.

In photos CC1: 09 À CC2: 13 À CC3: 11

NEEDLES = **4,5** and **4 mm.** (cable 80 and 100 cm)

OTHER =tapestry needle, stitch markers.



Nimbus is a cardigan worked topdown, it's a fast and easy knitting which will keep you warm in the early autumn days. When you knit it have fun imagining a sky with colored clouds and daring new color combinations.

POINTS USED

Stocking stitch: K on RS, P on WS

2/2 rib st.: * K2, P2 * rep ** to the end; next row : work sts as they appear.

Cloud:

Row 1 (RS): K9, turn

Row 2 (WS): Dst, P2, turn

Row 3 (RS): Dst, K4, v turn

Row 4 (WS): Dst, P6, turn

Row 5 (RS): Dst, K8, turn

Row 6 (WS): Dst, P10, turn

Row 7 (RS): Dst, K

ABBREVIATIONS

m = stitch (e);

MP = point mark;

pMP = pass MP

LD = right side of the work

LR = wrong side of the piece

dr = straight;

r = reverse;

viv = edge;

2ins = 2 sts together knit

3ins = 3 sts together knit

acc = simple overlap: slip a stitch without knitting it, 1 dr, overlap the passed stitch over that worked.

get = one toss

rip ** =

repeat from * to *

MEASURES

SIZES - S/ M . MEASURES OF THE FINISHED GARMENT:

Back width: 50 cm

Half front width: 20 cm

Raglan length: 30 cm

Length from underarm to hem: 60 cm

Sleeve length from underarm: 42 cm

Sleeve cuff circumference: 18 cm

PROCEDURE

With needles **4,5 mm** and cables 80 cm cast on **43 m** with **MC**.

SET-UP ROWS (RS): K1, place **SM**, K8, place **SM**, K25, place **SM**, K8, place **SM**, K1

Row 2(WS): P

Row 3: KFB, sSM, KFB * K to 1 st before SM, KFB, sSM, KFB* rep** 2 more times

Row 4: P

Row 5: * K to 1 st before SM, KFB, sSM, KFB * rep** to the end.

Repeat Rows 4 and 5 **6 more times**.

Repeat Row 4 **one more time**.

Row 17(RS): K to 1 st before SM, KFB, sSM, KFB, K to 1 st before SM, KFB, sSM, **change to CC1**, KFB, K3, work the **Cloud** continuing Row 7 of Cloud until 1 st before SM, KFB, sSM, **change to MC**, KFB, K to 1 st before SM KFB, sSM, KFB, K to the end.

Row 18(WS): with **MC**, P to the second SM, sSM, **change to CC1**, P to SM, sSM, cut CC1, **change to MC**, P to the end.

Repeat Rows 5 and 4 **6 times**

Row 31: with **CC2** work **Cloud** continuing Row 7 of Cloud until 1 st before SM, KFB, sSM, **change to MC**, KFB, * K to 1 st before SM, KFB, sSM, KFB * rep** to the end.

Row 32: with **MC** P to the 4 SM, **change to CC2** (being careful to weave the threads so as not to create holes, P to the end. Cut CC2

Repeat Rows 5 and 4 **6 times**

Row 45(RS): * K to 1 st before SM, KFB, sSM, KFB * rep** 2 more times, K to 1 st before SM, KFB, sSM, **change to CC3** KFB, K9, work **Cloud** continuing Row 7 of Cloud to the end.

Row 46 (WS): with **CC3** P to SM, **change to MC** being careful to weave the threads, P to the end. Cut CC3.

Repeat Rows 5 and 4 **2 times**

Stitches on needles: 233

Left Front: 25 sts; Left Sleeve: 56 sts; Back: 71 sts; Right Sleeve: 56 sts; Right Front: 25 sts.

Separate Sleeves and Body

Row 51(RS): K25, remove SM, place 56 sts onto holder or scrap yarn (left sleeve), cast on 5 sts, place SM, cast on 1 st, place SM, cast on 5, K71, place 56 sts onto holder or scrap yarn (right sleeve), cast on 5 sts, place SM, cast on 1 st, place SM, cast on 5 sts, K25

Row 25(WS): P

BODY (for convenience, the numbering from Rows 1 is resumed)

Row 1(RS): * K to SM, sSM, P1, sSM * rep** to the end

Row 2(WS): * P to SM, sSM, K1, sSM * rep** to the end

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 **7 times**

Row 17(RS): with CC1 K6, work **Cloud** continuing Row 7 of Cloud to SM, sSM, **change to MC** P the st. between SM, K to the end.

Row 18(WS): repeat Row 2 with MC, **change to CC1** when crossing. End the row and cut CC1.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 **21 times**

Row 61: * K to SM, sSM, P1, sSM * rep** once. **Change to CC2**, K11, work **Cloud** continuing Row 7 of Cloud to the end.

Row 62: with CC2, P to SM, sSM, cut CC2 and **change to MC**, K1, sSM, P to SM, sSM, K1, sSM, P to the end

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 **6 times**

Row 75: with CC3 K11, work **Cloud** continuing Row 7 of Cloud to SM, sSM, **change to MC**, P1, sSM, K to the end. Don't cut CC3.

Row 76: with **MC** P to SM, sSM, K1, sSM, P to SM, sSM, K1, sSM, **change to CC3** P to the end. Cut CC3

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 **12 volte**

Row 101: * K to SM, sSM, P1, sSM * rep** once. **change to CC1**, K3, work **Cloud**.

Row 102: with **CC1** P to SM, sSM, **change to CP** P to the end and K the st. between SM. Cut CC1

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 **4 volte**

Row 111: with **MC** K to SM, sSM, P1, sSM, **change to CC2**, K50, work **Cloud** continuing

Row 7 of Cloud to SM, sSM, **change to MC** P1, sSM, K to the end.

Row 112: with **MC** P to SM, sSM, K1, sSM, **change to CC2** P to SM, sSM **change to MC**, K1, sSM, P the end. Cut CC2

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 **2 volte**

Row 117: K to SM, sSM, P1, **change to CC3** K35, work **Cloud** continuing Row 7 of Cloud to SM, sSM, **change to MC** P1, sSM, K to the end

Row 118: with **MC** P to SM, sSM, K1, sSM, **change to CC3** P to SM, sSM, **change to MC** K1, sSM, P to the end. Cut CC3.

Change to **4 mm** needles and work **13 rows** in **2/2 rib st** for the hem.

PICK THE EDGE OF THE CARDIGAN

With needles **4 mm**, faccine RS, pick up along the right edge 3 sts every 4 rows, along the neck pick up every st and along the left side 3 sts every 4 row.

Work **7 rows** in **2/2 rib st.** loosely cast off.

SLEEVES

Worked in the round.

Start with Right sleeve. Slip the held stitches from holder to needles. Pick up and knit at underarm 5 sts, SM, pick up and knit 1 st (the purl st of the body), place **Smb**, pick up and kind 5 sts

Always P the st. between SM

K1 round increase 1 st. (68 sts).

Rounds 1-5: K

Rounds 6: K1, ssk, K to 3 sts before SM, K2tog, K1.

Repeat Rounds 1 - 6 **11 times in total.**

Repeat Rounds 1 - 5 **once**

Rounds 6A: [K2, K2tog] 2 times, [K1, K2tog] 10 times, [K2, K2tog] 2 times. Remove SM while working.

Chang **4 mm** and work **20 rounds** in **2/2 rib st.**

Loosely cast off all stitches.

MAKE THE LEFT SLEEVE.

Weave in all ends. Wash and block garment carefully. **NIMBUS** is ready to wear!
